Technical Information

VARIETY: 64% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Sangiovese, 2% Syrah

WINE MAKING: The 2020 Viviano was crafted to highlight the elegance and complexity achievable with Texas-grown grapes. This vintage underwent careful aging in oak barrels, which enhanced its depth, structure, and flavor integration. The oak aging process introduced subtle layers of vanilla and spice, which beautifully complement the wine's core flavors of dark cherry, blackberry, and plum. The result is a full-bodied wine with balanced acidity and refined tannins, showcasing the signature craftsmanship of Llano Estacado Winery in every glass.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS: The 2020 Viviano is best enjoyed at a temperature of 60-65°F (15-18°C) to bring out its rich aromas and complex flavors. This wine pairs excellently with grilled steaks, roasted lamb, and hearty pasta dishes. It also complements aged cheeses and charcuterie boards, making it a versatile choice for both casual gatherings and sophisticated dinners.
